### **Guidance Notes**

# **HE - Continuing Student Grant**

If you have successfully completed a level 3 programme at Milton Keynes College in the academic year 2022-2023 and enrol on to a Higher Education course with us, you will receive a grant of £500 paid in two instalments.

For students to qualify for the grant, you must be fully enrolled and attending your course, which we may confirm with your course team leader.

- Once the application is successfully processed then students will need to provide their bank account details for payments to be made.
- The first payment will then be made in December. Students must maintain their attendance during term two for the second payment, which will be made in May.
- Students who withdraw from their course between payments will not be eligible for the second payment.
- If a student withdraws from their course (with no extenuating circumstances) in term two or term three, they will be liable to repay the most recent payment only.
- If an application is submitted and/or processed after the Christmas holidays, only the second payment will be made to the student.
- This grant is from a limited fund and will be paid on first come, first serve basis. Once the fund has been exhausted, it will not be renewed until the following academic year.
