

22/23 Hairdressing Dress Code

There is no uniform to order for our Level 2 Hairdressing course, however all students must adhere to the salon dress code in order to participate in the salons:

The dress code for the course is as below:

- No jeans, jeggings or leggings
- No casual sports or leisure wear
- Colour code is black
- Smart professional clothing that is clean and pressed
- Trousers – any shape that suits you
- Tops – t-shirt or blouse with long or short sleeves and cover your waist – bare skin cannot be shown. Neck lines must not be low
- Shoes must be flat and closed – no sandals or trainers are permitted
- One set of ear studs & a nose stud is permitted. You may wear a watch and a wedding band.
- Day time make up must be worn.
- Nails must be clean and shaped. If you wear polish it must be chip proof. Acrylics must not be too long that they could injure a client or stop you learning the technique – please ensure that they are also filled in.
- Hair must be clean and neatly styled. May be worn up but a ponytail or a messy top knot is not permitted. If it is braided it needs to be tidy with no stray hairs and fixed with spray.
