HE - Continuing Student Grant

If you have successfully completed a level 3 programme at Milton Keynes College in the academic year 2023-2024 and enrol on to a Higher Education course with us. (Progressed from Level 3 to HNC)

OR

If you have successfully completed a Higher Education HNC programme at Milton Keynes College in the academic year 2023-2024 and enrol on to a Higher Education HND course with us (Progressed from HNC to HND)

you will receive a grant of **£500** paid in two instalments.

For students to qualify for the grant, you must be fully enrolled and attending your course which we may confirm with your course team leader. Students on Apprenticeship programme will not be eligible for the Grant.

- Once the application is successfully processed then students will need to provide their bank account details for payments to be made.
- The first payment will then be made in December. Students must maintain their attendance during term two for the second payment, which will be made in May.
- Students who withdraw from their course between payments will not be eligible for the second payment.
- If a student withdraws from their course (with no extenuating circumstances) in term two or term three, they will be liable to repay the most recent payment only.
- If an application is submitted and/or processed after the Christmas holidays, only the second payment will be made to the student.
