## 2.0 BOARD EFFECTIVENESS AND PERFORMANCE

- 2.1 Board Appointment (previously circulated as Confidential Paper 2.1A)
  - Ajira (AJ) Bouchada, who had applied to join the Board, attended for an interview
    having previously met informally with Sally Alexander and Karen Brown. The
    Committee had received a copy of her application form, skills self-assessment,
    competencies self-assessment and EDI monitoring form. AJ was known to Ruby
    through their connections with Women Leaders UK (AJ was a 2024 award winner).
  - AJ answered the Committee's questions and confirmed her time availability for the role including Board meetings, Committee meetings and link governor visits.
  - After AJ had left, the Committee made a collective decision, based on pre-determined criteria, and agreed unanimously to recommend she be appointed to the Board from for a three-year term of office, subject to a satisfactory DBS check.
